Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

Praise the Lord for his mercy and grace that we don't deserve! Praise Him for his faithful promises from the word of God as well! Ps 3:4, "I cried unto the Lord with my voice, and he heard me out of his holy hill." It's AWE-SOME being able to know and trust that God hears, and answers our prayers. We really appreciate and thank you all for continuously praying for us throughout all of these health problems. We know that we are exactly where God wants us right now; and have seen him hear our prayers, give us answers, and order our steps to where we are. He has also given us some clarity to what He's doing.

The doctor has been able to shed light on what's going on with Sarah, and start the healing process. With Sarah already having several auto-immune diseases, her body has developed another one that is attacking her nervous system. It is more severe and dangerous than the other ones she has. We are very blessed that the worst didn't happen in Mexico when we had no help.

The great thing is that the doc says he believes there is hope; Sarah's body is receiving the treatments well and is beginning the slow process of healing itself. Her body was very depleted of everything, so the first step is repairing and restoring a healthy balance with her organs, hormones, etc. After she is stronger the doctor is going to start neural therapies to try and heal her nervous system damage. We have already seen her body getting stronger every week that passes. It seems she is <u>almost</u> out of the critical state she was in that makes her body have the life threatening attacks. They are much fewer, not as strong, and lasting way less time than before. Praise God for his grace! Please continue to pray for her health, as she still has bad days. It's like two steps forward and one step backward.

The Lord has told us through multiple ways that we will be here for minimum six months. The doc expressed that he wants us back in Mexico serving the Lord, but we can't go back too early if we want to ensure true healing so that she doesn't digress once we return. The pastor of the church we are staying at told me that the prophets chamber is open for us for as long as we need...even six months to a year if needed! The Lord has us on a "forced" break to heal, recover, and recharge; and we are ok with it, because it's what God has setup. I didn't notice how drained all of us were in the work, even the kids. So we're thankful that the Lord is looking out for us.

The work in Mexico continues on faithfully with the young man I ordained in December, Angel. He has continued all services, outreach, discipleship, etc. in our absence. I don't want him to get wore out, so I asked another trusted man to help him out while we're gone. He and his family are moving into our house this week. Angel is a great man who loves the Lord, and I honestly believe part of this is to grow and mature him in our absence. It is something the Lord showed me before Sarah's health turned bad. Pray for him and the work in Mexico, please. November 1st is the three year anniversary of the work God started, and it's exciting to see what God is doing! Pray for the anniversary conference in November, and that if the Lord allows I could possibly be there for it.
